### Primary Panathlon Finals

#### Invite & Information

Dear school,

Congratulations on winning your local School Games **Primary Panathlon** competition. It is with great pleasure that we invite your school to now represent your SGO area at the Worcestershire School Games finals 2025. Please see below for further information, including details on how to register:

**Date:** Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025

**Venue:** Droitwich Leisure Centre (Briar Mill, WR9 0RZ). It will take place indoors, inside the sports hall. See below for details on parking.

**Timings:** 10am – 11.45am - please aim to arrive 10 minutes prior to your session start time.

**Parking:** Please park on site using the car park located at the back of the leisure centre. This car park is free of charge. From here, by foot, head towards the main entrance to the leisure centre. A member of the event team will be there to support and direct. There are also disabled parking bays at front of the building, if required.

**Drops/collections:** If you are being dropped/collected by mini bus or coach, please use the bus bay that is directly opposite, and walk over the road to the Leisure Centre. From here, head towards the main entrance to the leisure centre. A member of the event team will be there to support and direct.

**First Aid:** Where possible, please ensure one member of staff who attends with the team is first aid trained, but please note there will be an event first aider on site.

#### Team information:

- Teams should consist of 5 to 8 young people (open gender) in Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to Year 6) with a special educational need(s) and or disability. This event is not suitable for PMLD children.
- So for example, teams could include MLD, SLD, Deaf, Hearing Impaired and Autistic children.



### Event Details:

There will be a maximum of 6 teams (schools) in total. In their school team, pupils will rotate and compete across a range of activities from the Primary Panathlon menu. We hope to include: parachute popcorn, polybat, precision bean bag, new age kurling, flight path skittles and slam dunk.

Schools will collect and accumulate points as they rotate around the stations. There will be no mixing between schools – each school team will stay together throughout rotations.

All equipment will be provided and cleaned after use. All children will receive a medal and certificate. The winning team will win a trophy.
